TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

On May 15, 2018, the Application for a Temporary Restraining Order of DIANE PIWKO, Plaintiff herein, was heard before this court.

Based upon the pleadings, records, documents filed by counsel, and/or the arguments of counsel at the hearing, IT CLEARLY APPEARS:

- A. That unless RANDY RICE and BRUCE SHERBET, Defendants, are immediately restrained from certifying the results of the May 5, 2018 Farmersville mayoral election, that Defendants will commit the foregoing before notice and a hearing on Plaintiff's Application for Temporary Injunction.



B. Plaintiff will suffer irreparable harm if Defendants are not immediately restrained because the election may be improperly certified and there is no adequate remedy at law to grant Plaintiff complete, final and equal relief.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED RANDY RICE and BRUCE SHERBET, Defendants herein, and all of Defendants' officers, agents, servants, employees, successors and assigns, and attorneys are ORDERED to immediately cease and desist from certifying the May 5, 2018 Farmersville mayoral election results from the date of entry of this order until fourteen (14) days thereafter, or until further order of this Court.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff's Application for Temporary Injunction be heard on May 22, 2018 at 9:00 AM in the 401st. Defendants are commanded to appear at that time and show cause, if any exist, why a temporary injunction should not be issued against said Defendants.

The clerk of the above-entitled court shall issue a temporary restraining order in conformity with the law and the terms of this order upon the filing by Plaintiff of the bond hereinafter set.

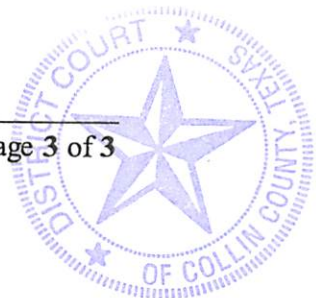


This order shall not be effective until Plaintiff deposits with the Clerk, a bond in the amount of \$100⁰⁰ in conformity with the law.
